



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.55 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by objection No.5 made by Wycombe Rural District Council and noted in the Register on 23rd March 1971.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.
