



In the Matter of Chalk Pit on the West Side of the Bridleway
from Bledlow to the Upper Icknield Way, Bledlow-cum-Saunderton,
Buckinghamshire.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 212 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Buckinghamshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 90 made by Lord Carrington and noted in the Register on 6 May 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Aylesbury on 29 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr J A Gibson, Clerk to the Bledlow-cum-Saunderton Parish Council, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr Patrick Talbot, of counsel, on behalf of the Objector.

The facts of this case are identical mutatis mutandis with those in In the Matter of Chalk Pit at the Rear of the Red Lion Public House, Bledlow, Bledlow-cum-Saunderton, (1978) Ref. No. 203/D/35.

For reasons given in my decision in that case I refuse to confirm the registration and I shall order the Parish Council to pay the Objector's costs on County Court Scale 4.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
