

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 204/D/36,37 and 38

In the Matter of Eastside Common, Godmanchester, Hunts D.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entries Nos 1 and 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No.CL.16 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Huntingdonshire and Peterborough County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 45 and 47 made by J Looker and W J N James respectively and noted in the Register on 3 December 1970 and the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos 1 and 2 in the said ownership section.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring in to the disputes at <u>Huntingdon</u> on 28 June 1978. The hearing was attended by Mr P Petty of Messrs. Hunnybun and Sons on behalf of the Freemen of Godmanchester and Mr Hough of Messrs. Winters on behalf of Huntingdon D.C. who agreed that both the Council and the Freemen had beneficial interests in the land and that the Council and the Freemen should be registered as joint owners, I therefore refuse to confirm the Entry No. 1 and confirm the Entry No. 2 modified by adding in column 3 the names:-

Henry John Mason Brian Stanley Reeves, and John Eric Toseland

as Trustees for the Freemen of Godmanchester

Mr Looker and Mr James did not appear.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
