COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



In the Matter of Port of the River Ouse and Backwaters. Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire (No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.99 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cambridgeshire County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 61 made by Mr W J N James and Objection No. 62 made by Mr H J Mason and both noted in the Register on 22 May 1972 and Objection No. 63 made by Mr H J Lincoln and Objection No. 64 made by Elysian Holdings Ltd and both noted in the Register on 27 June 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.
