DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. VG.29 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cambridgeshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 87 made by Mr C E Goodfellow and noted in the Register on 2 February 1972. The registration was made on the application of Mr J N Spencer.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at ~~Cambridgeshire~~ on 23 October 1984. The previous hearing of the dispute was re-opened and the decision thereon set aside by direction of the Chief Commons Commissioner. The re-opened hearing was not attended by either of the parties to the dispute, but Mr Spencer had written to say that he now withdrew his application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration and ~~make~~ no order as to costs.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require you to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
