

In the Matter of Guisborough Moor, Guisborough, Cleveland (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 287 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former North Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 0401 nade by Lord Guisborough and noted in the Register on 22 June 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitby on 24 May 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr J W D Fernie, solicitor, on behalf of the Langburgh Borough Council and by Mr P F G Fawcett, Lord Guisborough's land agent. Mr D C Petch, in consequence of whose application for a registration in the Rights section of the Register unit this application was made, did not appear and was not represented, but he stated in a letter dated 20 May 1977 that he did not wish to pursue the matter.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
