

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No 51/D/188

In the Matter of Land at Esclusham Mountain of Frondeg Flat, Minera, Wrexham Maelor BC

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL.262 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Denbighshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 103 made by Mr & Mrs Haddock and noted in the Register on 6 December 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 7 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr Thomas of Messrs D P Roberts & Co appeared for the Objectors, Mr & Mrs Haddock whose objection to the Entry at No 1 in the Land Section related to a small part of the Unit Land.

Mr Thomas satisfied me and these applicants for rights present at the hearing that Mr & Mrs Haddock had exclusive occupation of the land the subject of their Objection and that it was not subject to the exercise of common rights.

The Entries in the Rights Section and which are provisional will be dealt with by my decision on all the Units comprised in the Ruabon Mountain.

For these reasons I confirm the registration modified so as to exclude the land coloured red on the plan annexed to Objection No 103.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which motice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
