



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 271/D/65-66 & 67

In the Matter of Tract of land
southeast of Cwm Pydew, Llandrillo,
Glyndwr D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No CL. 200 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Merioneth County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 73 made by G I Barty King and the Duke of Westminster and noted in the Register on 13 October 1970, Objection No 83 made by C C Lamb and noted in the Register on 16 October 1970 and Objection No 270 made by the National Farmers Union and noted in the Register on 16 April 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Llangollen on 6 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr W George counsel instructed by Messrs Bremner Sons and Corlett for Mr Barty King and the Duke of Westminster, Mr T A G Sopwith on behalf of Mr C C Lamb and Mr Douglas Williams on behalf of the National Farmers Union.

A consent signed on behalf of the Ramblers' Association who registered the land as Common Land was produced requesting me to refuse to confirm the Registration.

For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
