



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/724-5

In the Matter of Bokiddick Downs,
Lanivet, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1/3 in the Land Section and at Entries No. 1, 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 633 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X62A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 9 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 16 January 1980.

The registration as common land is pursuant to an application to register rights of common made by E M Northcott, who appeared in person at the hearing. There are two other registrations of right; and the applicants R J Bray and W C E Phillips also appeared at the hearing. The County Council was represented by Mr Gill.

The County Council was now prepared to withdraw its Objection but it was agreed that the eastern boundary of the common should be the roadway running north to south and shown by a dotted line on the register map from near the red line G-H to near the letter F on that map. Accordingly I confirm the registrations with the modification that there be excluded from the land comprised in this Unit the area lying to the east of this roadway.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
