



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Boswednack Common,
Zennor

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 2 and 3 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 222 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X962 made by Mr F J Lawrey and noted in the Register on 29 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Camborne on 23 November 1982. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

In the absence of any of the parties and as the Objection only related to part of the Register Unit, I propose to allow the objection and limit the rights claimed to the remainder of the register unit.

For these reasons I confirm the registrations at Entry Nos. 2 and 3 with the following modification that the rights claimed are not exercisable over the land shown edged red on the plan annexed to the said objection.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
