

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No. 206/D/602

In the Matter of Boswens Common,
Sancreed, Penwith District Council,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 208 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X.1194 made by Rt Hon George Hugh Viscount Falmouth and noted in the Register on 7 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Camborne on 15 May 1979. At the hearing (1) Mr James Cyril Eddy upon whose application the registration was made, was represented by Mr T Le Grice solicitor of Pool Purchas & Le Grice, Solicitors of Penzance, and (2) Viscount Falmouth, who in addition to being the Objector is in the Ownership Section finally registered as the owner of the whole of the land, was represented by Mr J B G Holt, solicitor of Hancock and Laurence, Solicitors of Truro.

Mr Le Grice and Mr Holt said that they were agreed that the registration which is now of a right attached to Boswens Farm, Sancreed to graze 50 head of cattle over the whole of the land in this register unit, should be limited to 20 head of cattle. So with their agreement, I confirm the registration with the modification that in column 4 for "50 head of cattle", there be substituted "20 head of cattle".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
