

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Common and Waste between

DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land described above being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 570 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference South West Water Authority claimed to be the freehold owner of a part of the land in question ("the Unit land") and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Camborne on 14 January 1983.

At the hearing Mrs F G Canning, of the Water Authority, appeared on its behalf.

The part of the Unit land claimed by the Water Authority is the site of a Pumping Station which it operates. This site was acquired by Truro Rural District Council by a Conveyance dated 20 October 1969, the Vendor being the Imperial College of Science. The Water Authority is successor to the Rural District Council and I am satisfied that it is the owner of the Pumping Station site, shown coloured red on the attached plan. I shall accordingly direct the Cornwall County Council, as registration authority, to register South West Water Authority as the owner of the site under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965. I am not satisfied as to the ownership of the remainder of the Unit land, which will therefore remain subject to protection under section 9 of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
