DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 673 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X101A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 19 January 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 30 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Carne of R Hancock and Son, Solicitors of Callington appeared for the St Neot Parish Council and Mr Gill who appeared for the County Council.

The parties had agreed to request me to confirm the Registration with the modification that the area outside the purple line shown on a plan produced by Mr Gill be excluded.

For these reasons I confirm the registration with the following modification: that the area outside the plan annexed hereto be excluded from the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
