



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/799



In the Matter of land (a triangular piece) at Ebenezer Chapel, Grade-Ruan, Kerrier District, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 647 in the Register of Common Lane maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X 272 made by Trewitham Estate and noted in the Register on 12 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Camborne on 6 October 1980. At the hearing Cornwall County Council as registration authority, were represented by Mr D M Gill.

The land in this Register Unit is a triangular piece bounded by roads joining Mount Hermon, Tommy Daw's Hut and Ebenezer Chapel. The registration was made upon the application of Grade-Ruan Parish Council.

Mr Gill produced a letter dated 20 September 1980 signed by the clerk of the Parish Council in which he said (in effect) that his Council wished to withdraw their application for the registration of this land. For this reason I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
