



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 206/D/623

In the Matter of Land in the Village of Talskiddy,
St. Columb Major, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.318 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X915 made by Mr L R Rescorlan and noted in the Register on 28 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bodmin on 24 June 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J J Hooper, Solicitor, on behalf of the St. Columb Parish Council the applicant for the registration, and by Mr E Pate, Solicitor, on behalf of the Restormel Borough Council.

The Objector has died, but in a letter dated 2 July 1979, addressed to the Clerk of the Parish Council, Solicitors acting for his administratrix stated that they thought that there was no doubt of the status of the land comprised in the Register Unit as Common Land.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
