

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 206/D/495-6

In the Matter of Land to the east of and adjoining Higher Predannack Downs, Mullion, Cornwall (No 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No CL 487 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No X1237 made by Messrs J H H, B M, J E K, and H M Rowe and noted in the Register on 30 November 1972 and Objection No X742 made by Mr H Holford and noted in the Register on 7 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 14 December 1977. The hearing was attended by Mr T H Rowse, solicitor, on behalf of Mr and Mrs A B Thomas, the applicants for the registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objectors, but Mr Rowse informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
