

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Lower Predennack Cliff, Mullion,
Cornwall (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 (now 3 & 4) in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 473 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X103g made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 19 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 1 March 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr P F Ryder, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr L Mitchell, the applicant for the registration at Entry No. 1 (now 3) in the Rights section of the Register Unit.

It having been agreed that Mr Mitchell is entitled to a right of common over the whole of the land comprised in the Register Unit, it only remains for me to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
