



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos 206/U/551-553

In the Matter of Land at Marzion and St.
Michael's Mount, Marazion, Cornwall (No.2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.401 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. X151 made by H R H Charles, Prince of Wales, Duke of Cornwall and noted in the Register on 19 August 1970, Objection No. X696 made by the Hon. John St.Aubyn and noted in the Register on 5 March 1971, and Objection No.X1029 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 19 July 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 27 February 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr C Nicholls, Solicitor, on behalf of the National Trust. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mr and Mrs D. Reynolds, the applicants for the registration. However, on 5 February 1979 there was lodged with the County Council a request signed by Mr and Mrs Reynolds requesting the "withdrawal" of their registrations.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
