

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of the additional piece of land  
known as Tresean Common, Cubert, Carrick D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 440 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X 35A made by Cornwall County Council and noted in the Register on 8 January 1973 and objection No. X 1492 made by Cubert Commoners Association noted in the Register on 12 December 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 15 March 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr D M Gill on behalf of Cornwall County Council and Mr J Coad on behalf of Cubert Commoners Association, who withdrew their objections

For <sup>the</sup> reason I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.

In the Matter of Cliff Land at Gunwalloe  
Fishing Cove, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 483 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X 589 made by Mr B G Cattran and noted in the Register on 1 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 12 June 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill of the Registration Authority, but by no one else. The registration was made on the application of Gunwalloe Parish Meeting. The grounds of Mr Cattran's Objection are that he has the absolute freehold title and the land was not common land at the date of registration.

Mr Gill produced a letter dated 8 June 1979 from the Parish Meeting stating in effect that they wished to withdraw the registration as common land. In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
