



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Tredinnery Common,  
St. Buryan, Cornwall

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 503 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X256 made by Mr W J and Mrs D E Naukerwis and noted in the Register on 3 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exuro on 27 February 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard. It was, however stated in a letter dated 6 February 1979 addressed to the County Council that the Council for the Preservation of Rural England, the applicant for the registration, wished to "withdraw" it.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
