



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Tremarcombe Common,
St Cleer, Caradon D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Ownership Section of Register Unit No CL. 150 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No X112 made by British Rail and noted in the Register on 30 July 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 15 July 1970.

This hearing took place immediately after the hearing relating to Unit No CL. 159 and the parties attending the hearing relating to CL. 159 also attended this hearing and agreed that I should confirm the Entry at No 1 in the Ownership Section modified so as to exclude the land identified on the plan attached to Objection No X112.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
