



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.206/D/58

In the Matter of Trewellard Common
(or Carne Hill), Pendeen, Cornwall (No.3).

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No.4 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 493 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. X948 made by Mrs J.E.Calvert and noted in the Register on 1st May 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Truro on 11th March 1975. The hearing was attended by Mr.P.Trembath, son of Mrs M.Trembath, the applicant for the registration, and Mr D.Pepperell, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

This is a purely technical dispute brought about by Mrs Calvert's Objection to the registration at Entry No.1 in the Land Section of the Register Unit, which by virtue of section 5(7) of the Commons Registration Act 1965 is an Objection to this registration. However, Mrs Calvert's Objection related solely to the land lying to the east of the red line A-B on the Register Map. Since this land has been excluded from the registration which is the subject of this dispute upon Mrs Trembath's application dated 7th June 1972 it only remains for me to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
