



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

DECISION

These disputes relate to registrations in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 252 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cornwall County Council and are occasioned by Objections made by Mr F T Boundy, viz Objection No. X518 noted in the Register on 23 April 1971, Objection No. X519 noted in the Register on 15 February 1972 and Objection X969 noted in the Register on 23 March 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes at Bodmin on 15 January 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr Gill of the Registration Authority, by Mr F T Boundy and Mr W Jasper.

Mr Boundy's Objection No. X518 was to Entry No. 1 in the Rights Section which is a right to graze 6 cattle over the land, registered on the application of Mr W Jasper. By a letter dated 8 January 1980, Mr W Jasper's Solicitors indicated that he had withdrawn his application, and Mr W Jasper so informed me at the hearing. Accordingly I refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.

Mr Boundy's Objections Nos. X519 and X969 were to Entry No. 4 in the Rights Section which is a right to graze 30 cattle or 30 ponies or 150 sheep over the land and was registered on the application of Mr Richard Jasper. Mr Richard Jasper did not appear but it transpires that he was not notified of the hearing, which will be re-opened at a date and place to be fixed for the purpose of inquiring into the disputes as to the right which he registered.
