

OMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 262/U/513

In the Matter of a Public Watering Place at Longcroft Bowness

DECISION_

his reference relates to the question of the ownership of land above mentioned eing the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No.CL.389 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County ouncil of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons egistration Act 1965 as the owner.

ollowing upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the wnership of the land at Keswick on 29 June 1982.

There was no appearance at the hearing.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and it will therefore remain subject to protection under section of the Act of 1965.

am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
