



In the Matter of Birkbeck Falls Common,
Orton, Cumbria (No. 6)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 21 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 9 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2/140 made by the Crosby Ravensworth Commoners Committee and noted in the Register on 10 February 1972. I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 30 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J T Relph, the Secretary of the Commoners Committee, and I gave leave for Mr R Wilson, the applicant for the registration, to be represented by Mr T Parkins, his land agent.

Mr Relph and Mr Parkins informed me that it had been agreed that the registration should be reduced by 1 pony.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modification; namely, the substitution of "1 pony" for "2 ponies".

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
