COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



In the Matter of Blencarn Fell, Culgaith, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos 18 and 13 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL.323 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 134 made by Mr J K Stamper and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 31 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr J M Thompson, the applicant for the registration at Entry No 18, and Mr J Beaty, Mrs E W Beaty, and Mr J W Beaty, the applicants for the registration at Entry No. 13, and by Mr T M Armison, Solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

Mr Armison informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
