



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No.45/D/60

In the Matter of Brant Fell,
Sedbergh, Cumbria.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos.7, 65, 66 and 84 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No.CL 26, in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former West Riding of Yorkshire County Council and is occasioned by Objection No.1926 made by Mr Joseph Gibson and noted in the Register on 25th August 1972.

All the persons entitled to be heard at the hearing of this dispute have agreed upon the terms of the decision to be given by me and have sent to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners particulars of such terms signed by or on behalf of all such persons.

I am satisfied that there is no person who, if a hearing were held, would be entitled to be heard upon giving his name and address to me and satisfying me that he had succeeded to the interest, or part of the interest of any other person.

I am willing to give a decision in accordance with the proposed terms and I accordingly (a) refuse to confirm the registration at Entry No.7; and (b) confirm the registration at Entry Nos.65, 66, and 84 with the following modifications, namely the deletion of the words "Right of piscary" in each Entry.
