

In the Matter of Canker Beck Site, Seaton and Camerton, Cumbria.

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 412 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 103 made by the Executors of J Conaway, deceased, and Objection No. 104 made by Mr G Brown and both noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 11 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J Fryer Spedding, of counsel, on behalf of the Earl of Lonsdale, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objectors, but I heard Mrs A Mitchell, who claimed to be the owner of a small part of the land comprised in the Register Unit.

Mr Fryer Spedding informed me that Lord Lonsdale was willing that the land claimed by Mrs Mitchell should be excluded from the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration with the following modifications: namely, the exclusion of the land claimed by Mrs Mitchell.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 5 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
