



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965.

In the Matter of Glenridding Common,  
Patterdale, Cumbria (No. 1)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 101 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 2/8 made by the National Trust and noted in the Register on 21 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 22 April 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr P Watson, the Land Agent of the National Trust.

The Objection relates only to the part of the land comprised in the Register Unit North of the line A-B and West of the line B-C on the Register Map. Mr Watson informed me that it was accepted by the National Trust that the registration at Entry No. 4 in the Rights Section of the Register Unit properly extended to the whole of the land comprised in the Register Unit.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
