

In the Matter of Grisedale Forest, Patterdale, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registrations at Entry Nos. 1 to 5 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 57 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registrations at Entry Nos. 1 to 8 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 29 October 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr D Mellor, Solicitor, on behalf of Ms E A Little and Miss M A Robinson, the applicants for the registrations at Entry Nos. 2, 4 and 5 in Register Unit No. CL 57 and at Entry Nos. 2, 7 and 8 in Register Unit No. CL 160.

The conflict is more apparent than real, having been caused by an error on the part of the registration authority, the former Westmorland County Council. This error did not affect in any way the validity of the registrations the subject of this reference, and I therefore confirm the registrations.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
