

In the Matter of Kilwell or The Sheep Pens in
Stainton Village, Dacre, Cumbria (No. 3)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 351 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objection 125 made by Mr H Noblett and Objection No. 165 made by the Dacre Parish Council and both noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Penrith on 14 October 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Noblett.

Since by my decision in Ref. 262/D/776 I have refused to confirm the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit, it follows that I must also refuse to confirm this registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.


