## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 466 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County Council and is occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 104 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Council.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Whitehaven on 2 March 1982. The hearing was attended by Mrs A Templer, Chairman of Netherwasdale Parish Meeting.

As there were no registrations in the Rights Section I pointed out to Mrs Templer that the registration could only be confirmed if it could be established that the land was waste land of the manor.

Mrs Templer admitted that she had no such evidence.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous <u>in point of law</u> may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
