## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 232 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 119 made by the Hethersgill parish Council and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.
