

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965



Reference No 262/D/71

In the Matter of Park Broom Green,  
Stanwix, Cumbria.

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No VG 11 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 8 made by Mr W M Wannop and noted in the Register on 2 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 4 July 1979. The hearing was not attended by any person entitled to be heard.

The Objection relates to only part of the land comprised in the Register Unit, but the plan attached to the Objection seems to bear no relation at all to the Register Map. In the absence of any representation by or on behalf of the Objector, I shall ignore the Objection and I confirm the registration without modification.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
