Supplemental Decision

Since the Decision dated 21 August 1979 (amended 10 January 1980), I have been informed that in 1961 Castlerigg Green was sold to Carlisle Diocesan Board of Finance by the Parish Council of St John Castlerigg and Wythburn, the body in which the Green was under the Decision directed to be registered. The sale to the Diocesan Board was completed by a Conveyance dated 10 October 1961 made between the Parish Council and the Diocesan Board.

In these circumstances I shall set aside my Decision so far as it relates to Castlerigg Green and, being satisfied that the Diocesan Board is the owner of Castlerigg Green, I shall direct the Cumbria County Council, as registration authority, to register Carlisle Diocesan Board of Finance as the owner under Section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
