



In the Matter of Side Fell, Askerton, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 7 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 96 made by Mr D Ferguson and noted in the Register on 2 October 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 7 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr P Pickles, solicitor, on behalf of the Hon. Roger Eden, the applicant for the registration, and by Mr E S Bliss, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

Mr Bliss informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the Objection.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
