



In the Matter of Tarns Dub, Holme St Cuthbert, Cumbria  
(No. 2)

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 454 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 118 made by Mr Wise, Objection No. 223 made by Mr R G Dixon, and Objection No 224 made by Mr Harry Ireland and all noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 10 November 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr P W Pickles, solicitor, on behalf of Mr A E B Standish, Mr G M Kerr, and Mr R K Lockhead, the applicants for the registration, Mr J F Moffath, solicitor, on behalf of Mr Wise and Mr Dickson, and Mr F B Hart-Jackson, solicitor, on behalf of the personal representatives of Mr Ireland.

Mr Pickles informed me that he was instructed not to pursue the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
