



In the Matter of The Beck, Bewcastle, Cumbria (No. 2)

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Rights section of Register Unit No. CL 305 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Cumbria County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 184 made by the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and noted in the Register on 4 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Carlisle on 7 April 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr W T Forrester, the applicant for the registration, in person and by Miss A G Braddock, solicitor, on behalf of the Objector.

By my decision in In the Matter of The Beck, Bewcastle (No. 1) (1981), Ref. No. 262/D/31 I have confirmed the registration in the Land section of the Register Unit with the exclusion of certain land there specified.

Miss Braddock stated that she was instructed to agree that Mr Forrester was entitled to a right of turbary over the land remaining in the Register Unit under the Black Lyne Inclosure Award of 1820.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
