



In the Matter of Tract of land at Blitterlees,

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land section of Register Unit No. CL 458 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the former Cumberland County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 217 and 219 made by the said Council and noted in the Register on 3 and 4 August 1972 and to the registration at Entry No. 1 of the same register unit occasioned by Objection No. 219 made by the said County Council and noted on the Register as aforesaid and the conflicting registration at Entry No. 2 in the Ownership section of Register Unit No. CL 458 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Council, and to the registration at Entry No. 2 in the said Ownership Section occasioned by the conflicting registration at Entry No. 1 in the said Ownership Section.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Keswick on 30 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr L Jay, Solicitor with the Cumbria County Council who informed me that the applications in the Land Sections had been withdrawn and invited me not to confirm any of the registrations.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registrations in the Land Section and the Ownership Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
