

In the Matter of pieces of land at Farway Hill and Broad Down, Fairway and Southleigh

## DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 1 in the Land Section and at Entries Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 245 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 497 made by R K Mathews Esq and noted in the Register on 18 December 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Exeter on 2 June 1981. The hearing was attended by Mr Miles of Messrs Dunning and Co for the applicants and Mr Neason for the objectors.

I was informed that the applicants withdrew the applications at Entries Nos. 1 and 2 in the Rights Section.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registrations in either the Land Section or the Rights Section.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
