



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 209/D/175

In the Matter of Wrangaton Green, Ugborough,  
Devon

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No.VG.98 in the Register of Town or Village Greens maintained by the Devon County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1169 made by the former Devon County Council, and noted in the Register on 11 September 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dartmouth on 21 May 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J Broom, Solicitor, on behalf of the County Council. There was no appearance by or on behalf of Mrs M N Lobb, the applicant for the registration, but in a letter dated 8 May 1980, addressed to the Office of the Commons Commissioners, her solicitors stated that they had been instructed to "withdraw" the application.

In these circumstances I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
