In the Matter of a piece of land called Churchland Green containing 0.18 acre or thereabouts in the parish of Morden, Dorset

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of land known as Churchland Green in the parish of Morden being the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. VG 26 in the Register of Town and Village Greens maintained by the Dorset County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference no person claimed to be the freehold owner of the land in question and no one claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Poole on 10 July 1980.

Mr D S Harper appeared for the County Council and Mrs A O Dalby (the Clerk) for Morden Parish Council.

In the absence of any evidence I am not satisfied that any person is the owner of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Dorset County Council, as registration authority, to register Morden Parish Council as the owner of the land under section 8(3) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggreived by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
