



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/311-312

In the Matter of Hinton Moor and Pilsmoor,
Pamphill, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 60 in the Land Section and Entry Nos. 1-7 and 9-14 in the Rights Section of Register Unit No. CL 60 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 450 made by the Clerk of Dorset County Council and noted in the Register on 10 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Poole on 20 November 1979. The hearing was attended by Mr Holly of the Dorset County Council, and by Mr Lock, of Kingston Lacy and Corfe Castle Estates, the agents of Mr H J R Bankes who claims ownership of the land.

The Objection is on the ground that part of the land is highway, the particular part ("the highway part") being identified on the plan 4445/42 accompanying the objection. It appeared that all interested parties had agreed to the exclusion of the highway part from the registration but otherwise to the confirmation of the registrations, and accordingly I confirm the registrations modified so as to exclude the highway part.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
