



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

In the Matter of Horton Common (Part)
Horton, Wimborne D

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 122 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL. 122 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No 756A made by the Dorset County Council and noted in the Register on 8 August 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Bournemouth on 28 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr ~~Holly~~ (on behalf of the Dorset County Council and Mr Jackson on behalf of the Wimborne District Council) *Harford*
and Mr Mendel on behalf of Wimborne Parish Council (the successors to Horton Parish Council)

Harford Mr/Holly withdrew the Objection.

For this reason I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
