

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 210/D/43-45

In the Matter of Ibberton Hill, Ibberton, Dorset

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 47/1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.47 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 21 made by The Rivers Estate Company Ltd and noted in the Register on 5th August 1969 and by Objection No. 472 made by the lerk of the former Dorset County Council and Objection No. 331 made by the Executors of Capt G H L F Pitt-Rivers, deceased, and both noted in the Register on 10th March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 6th January 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr D S Harper, solicitor, on behalf of the County Council and by Mr A W Richards, the agent of Mr Cooper, the successor in title of the executors of Capt Pitt-Rivers.

Mr Harper informed me that the County Council wished to "withdraw" its objection and that he would support the application for the registration made by the Ibberton Parish Council.

The facts of this case are similar <u>mutatis mutandis</u> to those in <u>In the Matter of Ibberton Long Down</u>, <u>Ibberton (1976)</u>, <u>Ref. Nos 210/D/38-42</u>. There are no rights registered in respect of this land nor is there any evidence that it was waste land of the Manor of Ibberton at the date of the hearing.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
