



## COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference Nos. 210/D/99-103

In the Matter of Land at South Bowood,  
Netherbury,  
Dorset.

## DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 26 in the land section of Register Unit No. CL 27 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 32 made by Mr J B Hill and noted in the Register on 18 December 1969, Objection No. 203 also made by Mr Hill, Objection No. 202 made by Mr R T Brown, Objection No. 315 made by Mr G C Street, and Objection No. 454 made by the Clerk of the former Dorset County Council and all noted in the Register on 28th January 1970.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 22 April 1976. The hearing was attended by Mr Brown and Mr Street. None of the other persons entitled to be heard attended or was represented.

In the absence of any evidence in support of the registration I refuse to confirm it

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
