



COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/354

In the Matter of Land called The Common
Sretisbury in the County of Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No 153 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL.153 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection No. 1015 made by Mr A Tory Esq and noted in the Register on 10 October 1972.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 23 January 1981. The hearing was attended by Miss S Cameron of Counsel instructed by Messrs. Latcher and Son Solicitors of Ringwood appearing for Mr Tory, the objector. Mrs R L Speke who had applied for the registration on 23 October 1969 is now dead and no one entitled to be heard under Regulation 19 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 appeared in support ~~of~~ the application.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30 (1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
