

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

## In the Matter of Millhams, Christchurch, Hampshire.

## DECISION

This reference relates to the question of the ownership of part of the land known as Millhams, Christchurch, being part of the land comprised in the Land Section of Register Unit No. C.L.160 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Hampshire County Council of which no person is registered under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965 as the owner.

Following upon the public notice of this reference Mr. W.H. Mooring Aldridge and Mr. R.H. Mooring Aldridge claimed to the freehold owners of the land in question and no other person claimed to have information as to its ownership.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the question of the ownership of the land at Winchester on 25th October 1973.

At the hearing the claimants were represented by Mr. R.H. Mooring Aldridge.

The land in question was conveyed to the claimants by Lloyds Bank Ltd by a conveyance dated 25th September 1956.

I am satisfied that the claimants are the owners of the land, and I shall accordingly direct the Hampshire County Council, as registration authority, to register them as the owners of the land under section 8(2) of the Act of 1965.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations, 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
