

In the Matter of Stockwood Common,

Stockwood, Dorset

DECISION

These disputes relate to the registration at Entry No. 84 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 84 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and are occasioned by Objection No. 361 made by Mr P Pleydell Bouverne, Mr J L Lowther, and Mr M P Wyndham and Objection No. 449 made by the Clerk of the former Dorset County Council and both are noted in the Register on 29 March 1971.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Dorchester on 5 March 1980. The hearing was attended by Mr J G Nicholls, Solicitor, on behalf of Mr G T Collyer, the applicant for the registration. There was no appearance by or on behalf of the Objectors, but by a letter dated 16 August 1979 addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners the Clerk of the County Council gave notice that Objection No. 449 would be withdrawn, and by a letter dated 1 October 1979 addressed to the Clerk of the Commons Commissioners by the Solicitors for Mr Pleydell Bouvers, Mr Lowther, and Mr Wyndham notice was given that Objection No. 361 would be withdrawn.

In these circumstances I confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
