

COMMONS REGISTRATION ACT 1965

Reference No. 210/D/368-370

In the Matter of the tract of about 309.7 acres called New Mills Heath, in the Parish of Corfe Castle, Dorset

DECISION

This dispute relates to the registration at Entry No. 272/1 in the Land Section of Register Unit No. CL 272 in the Register of Common Land maintained by the Dorset County Council and is occasioned by Objection Nos. 145, 920 and 1042 made by (1) H E Scott Esq (2) ECC Ball Clays Limited and (3) H J R Bankes Esq respectively and all noted in the Register on 26 February 1973.

I held a hearing for the purpose of inquiring into the dispute at Poole on 9 July 1980.

The Ramblers' Association which had made the application for the registration withdrew it by letter to the Commons Commissioners dated 3 July. No other person appeared to support the application.

For these reasons I refuse to confirm the registration.

I am required by regulation 30(1) of the Commons Commissioners Regulations 1971 to explain that a person aggrieved by this decision as being erroneous in point of law may, within 6 weeks from the date on which notice of the decision is sent to him, require me to state a case for the decision of the High Court.
